Eger could be described as a Baroque jewellery-box, being one of the most attracting cities of Hungary. Ádám and his club mate András Szabó were members of the Hungarian relay team winning bronze medal in World University Championship in 2008. Among the women Ágnes Simon has the most valuable results winning senior ski orienteering world champion titles.
